

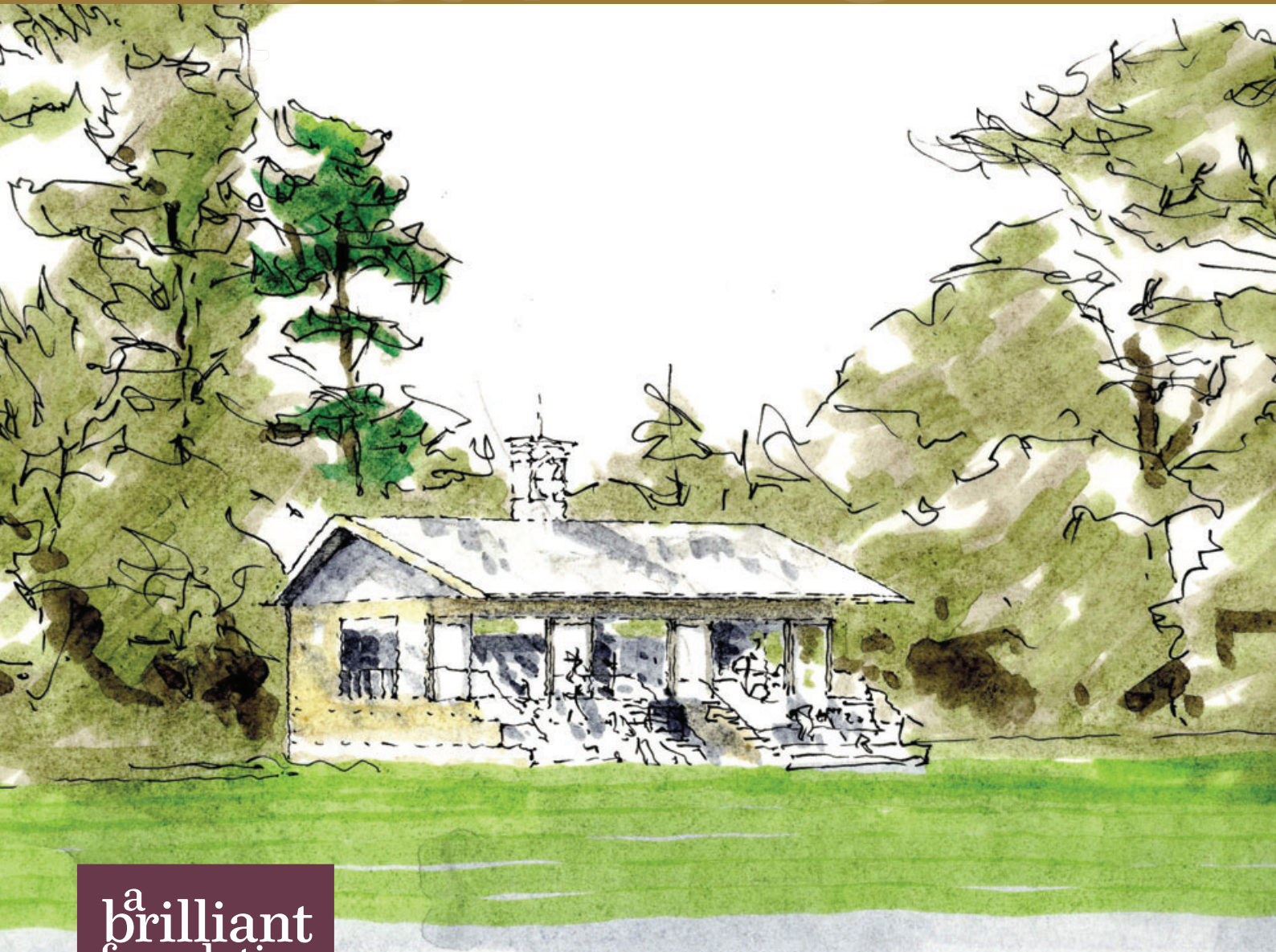

The school Governors and staff are committed to enhancing the sporting experiences available at Wells and our new sports pavilion on Cedars Field will reflect this commitment.

On the lower floor there will be two changing rooms, each equipped for a rugby team or a County 2nd XI cricket team; a separate changing room for officials and plenty of room for kit storage. A lift or stairs will take people to the large room above, where on match day light snacks along with hot and cold drinks will be available; lunch for up to 30 will be served, and where in the evening the players and their friends can relax.
